**DATE:** 10:00 AM, Tuesday, July 15th, 2025

**LOCATION:** Livestock Central, presented by KWS Hybrid Rye Show Ring, Ag in Motion Show Site, Langham

**ARRIVAL:** Cattle may start arriving after 5 PM, Monday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All animals must be in place by 8:00 AM Tuesday morning.

**RELEASE:** Immediately following the awards or after 4:30 PM.

**STALLING:** There is no stalling available. You will be tying to your trailer. There will be a designated area in the southwest part of the show for you to park.

**POWER:** There is no power available. **Please bring your own generator.**

**WATER:** There will be water for cattle available on site.

**JUDGE:** Baxter Blair, McLean, SK

**ANNOUNCER:** TBD

**PRIZES:** Cash and prizes up for grabs!

### SHOW RULES:

- Eligible to junior exhibitors aged 6-21 as of January 1, 2025.
  - PeeWee – 6-8 (PeeWee exhibitors may be accompanied by an adult in the ring)
  - Junior – 9-12
  - Intermediate – 13-15
  - Senior- 16-21
- Entry Process will be done on the Agribition Online Entry System <https://app.agribition.com/livestock/sign-in>  
Entries will open on **Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>**. Payment is due upon entry via credit card or etransfer.

**Entries close on Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup>.**
- Entry Fee is \$100 per class. There is no charge for Showmanship and Judging classes.
- Each breed must have a minimum of 20 entries to have its own breed show.
- Classes will be split after 7 head. Grand Champion of each class will compete in the Supreme classes.
- If all breeds do not have enough entries to make a breed show all classes will be split into Continental and British breeds.

- Registration number MUST be submitted with the accompanying online entry forms. Tattoos will be checked.
- Bull calves and heifer calves can be shown as a cow/calf pair, and individually.
- Jackpot Steers will be shown by age. The top two from each class will advance to the championship class.
- All steers must be dehorned and castrated.
- All cattle must have RFID tags in place.
- The Ag in Motion Show Committee and staff reserve the right to rearrange class numbers if needed.
- The Ag in Motion Show Committee reserve the right to refuse or dismiss any entry deemed unmanageable.
- The Ag in Motion Show Committee and staff reserve the right to decide on any point not covered in the rules and correct any errors to make necessary alterations.
- Everyone attending this event does so at their own risk and does not hold Ag In Motion, volunteers, or anyone of the organizing committee responsible or liable for any injury, illness, or accident.

**CLASSES:**

- Youth Judging.
  - Showmanship.
  - Female, January 1 to May 15, 2025.
  - Female, born 2024.
  - Female, born in 2023 with her own 2025, natural, calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible for calf classes.
  - Female, born in 2022 or earlier, with her own 2025, natural, calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible for calf classes.
  - Bull, born 2025.
  - Bull, born in 2024.
  - Bull, born in 2023.
  - Jackpot Steer, born in 2025.
- \*\* Only Grand Champion shows in Supreme classes.
